Meeting Minutes

The Abilene Recreation Commission met on Monday, November 8 at 5:30 p.m. at the Abilene Community Center. Present were Recreation Commission members Angie Evans, Billy Hansen, Derek Berns and Director Kellee Timbrook. Chris Cease and Shawn Herrman were not in attendance.

Angie Evans, Secretary, called the meeting to order. Billy Hansen moved to accept the August 23, 2021 meeting minutes as presented, Derek Berns seconded the motion, motion passed.

Kellee gave the update of the revenue and expense report for the commission through October 2021. Derek Berns made the motion to receive the Financial Report, Billy Hansen seconded the motion, motion passed.

Under old business, Kellee updated members on the new volleyball net system and curtain. December 13 was set for the start date to install the new systems and curtain. S & K Electric would come in and set up the new switches to operate the new systems once they are installed.

Under new business, Kellee presented the 2022 calendar of Recreation Commission meeting dates. Holiday hours were also presented. The Abilene Community Center will be closed Friday, December 24, Saturday, December 25 and Saturday, January 1. Thursday, Dec. 23 the community center will be open Noon-8pm, and Friday, Dec. 31 it will be open Noon-5pm. Kellee also let the commission know about upcoming bids including bathroom floors at the Community Center, Tennis and Pickleball court resurfacing, AC/Heat control system, park picnic tables, photo & shirt bids, and a new playground system.

Under the Director's report, Kellee updated the commission that staff evaluations had been completed. The basketball Athletic Academy had 90 participants and has been a great partnership with the school. The Halloween event that was held at Old Abilene Town had around 750 participants and staff was working on the Christmas events that will be held Dec. 4 including Breakfast with Santa, Sant Train, Outdoor Lighting Contest, Mayor's tree lighting, Turkey Drop and Snowball Drop.

Having no further business, Billy Hansen moved to adjourn the meeting, Derek Berns seconded the motion, the motion passed.
