Background:

At the March 20 study session, representatives from Mennonite Housing and Windy Ridge Development presented an idea to develop senior housing in Abilene using state tax credits.

The property they want to purchase, south of 21st St and east of Buckeye Ave, must be rezoned from C-3 to R-3. To apply for the state tax credits, the state requires written confirmation from the municipal zoning authority (the city commission) that the proposed use is within the parameters of existing conforming zoning designations.

Due to the May deadline to submit the tax credit application, and the City's request to review the feasibility study (expected completion April 14), I wanted to begin a discussion to have a letter ready for approval if the governing body elected to move forward.

This is a non-binding, noncommittal letter. Any rezoning decisions would still go through the required process of notification of those within 1000' of the development, a public hearing and review by the planning commission, and final approval by the city commission.

Recommendation:

Byron Adrian with Mennonite Housing will be at the study session to discuss the results of their feasibility study.

RE: Proposed Abilene Project from Mennonite Housing

Dear Ms. Ice:

Mennonite Housing has approached the City of Abilene on a proposed Senior (55 and older) development. Mennonite Housing has selected a site for the proposed development on the east side of Buckeye Ave (K-15 Highway) and south of 21st St. The site is approximately 4-5 acres of developable land. A drainage detention pond is located to the southeast of the property and is designed to handle the development of this acreage. The property is currently zoned commercial. A map showing the property location and lot layout is enclosed.

The current property owner has indicated a willingness to sell the property to Mennonite Housing conditioned on approval of the project at all levels. The property will need to be rezoned to R-3, Multi-Family. It is my understanding that an application will be made to rezone the property following an award of the tax credit application, which application will then be reviewed and acted upon by the City in accordance with applicable law.

This letter confirms my opinion that the proposed project and zoning change to Multi-Family development is consistent with the surrounding property zoning and the city's long-term land use plan. Additionally, the proposed project will help to address the city's ongoing shortage and lack of affordable housing, especially in the 55 and older demographic. This shortage was first recognized in a county-wide housing study conducted by the Dickinson County Economic Development Corporation in 2018 and updated in 2022.

Please feel free to contact me with additional questions. I appreciate your consideration of Mennonite Housing's project request; the project will benefit the Abilene Community and add much-needed housing options for seniors.

Background:

During the 2022 budgeting process the City Commission approved the purchase of a truck for Flood Control, with a \$60,000.00 budget from the general fund. At the January 24, 2022, City Commission meeting the Commission approved a bid from Holm Automotive for the truck. In January of 2023 Chris Eckert from Holm Automotive told Lon and Joe that they were going to have to withdraw from the bid because they were never able to secure a truck.

This truck will replace a 2002 Ford which is currently the spray truck. The 2002 Ford will be reassigned as the shop service truck.

Staff sought three comparable bids for a 1-ton regular cab 4-wheel drive truck. Bidders were given 2 options 1 was truck only and 2 was truck with flatbed installed.
