The Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee met last Tuesday with Foster Design Associates. Discussion centered on the steering committee's role, input on community issues and key planning goals and the park master plan. Also included in the discussion was the community questionnaire to be distributed this summer.

The community survey for the sports complex went live last Friday. The survey is on the community engagement dashboard and can be accessed from the website and social media. We are putting QR codes in the newspaper, water bill and around town to make the survey as accessible as possible. We will also have paper copies available at City Hall, the Senior Center and the Community Center. We plan to have the survey open for two weeks.

Mitch Feeney, a Water Treatment Plant Operator, has received his Water I Operator certification. As I've said in the past, this is not an easy certification and requires a lot of individual study. Congratulations to Mitch.

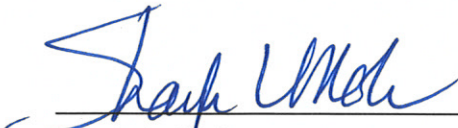

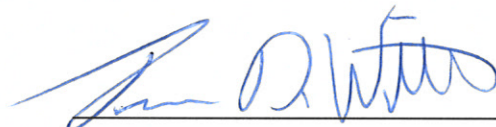
13. Adjournment - Consider a motion to adjourn May 22, 2023, City Commission Meeting
